European Union imposes European-wide price caps on wholesale tariffs and retail rates.

- European Model is based on a strong political vision with constructive pragmatism: to address the concerns of their citizens, and to provide European solutions for European problems
- It introduced lower pan-European voice roaming prices in the form of a "Eurotariff" designed to build a "real Europe for Citizens"

The Arab States also started to regulate International mobile roaming prices (price ceiling) within Arab States through Arab Regulators' Network (AREGNET).

They regulates retail rates by imposing a 15% ceiling cap on the local calls.


Mobile Roaming arrangement of respective country have with the other Member countries




