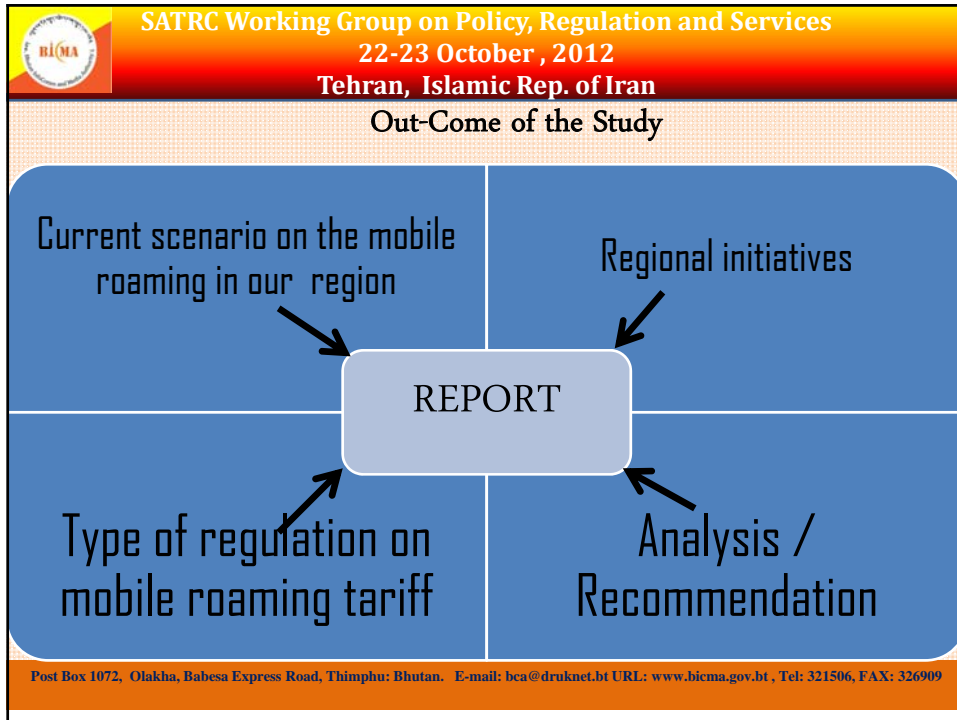

European Union imposes European-wide price caps on
wholesale tariffs and retail rates.


- ❖ European Model is based on a strong political vision with constructive pragmatism: to address the concerns of their citizens, and to provide European solutions for European problems
- ❖ It introduced lower pan-European voice roaming prices in the form of a "Eurotariff" designed to build a "real Europe for Citizens"

- ❖ They regulates retail rates by imposing a 15% ceiling cap on the local calls.

International organizations		
ITU	A number of administrations have submitted proposals to include roaming provisions into the revision of the International Telecommunications Regulations. ITU Study Group on Tariffs & Accounting is discussing a draft Recommendation.	
OECD	Proposed "Recommendation on International Mobile Roaming Services" for voice and data roaming.	
WTO	A number of governments have submitted a request to consider how existing WTO instruments may be used to deliver (wholesale/retail) roaming services on "more competitive terms and conditions".	
Regional initiatives		
Arab World	The Gulf Cooperation Council adopted a ministerial resolution some three years ago. More recently it announced the 2 nd phase of implementation and, as from July 2011, operators in the 6 Gulf states will implement a further reduction voice roaming tariffs between Gulf States.	
Americas	A number of regional organizations have conducted studies (Regulatel, CITEI IIRSA). IIRSA South American Roaming Agreement implemented throughout 2010. First phase focused on increasing volume and quality of roaming traffic. Regulators are now concerned with pricing issues. Some countries are considering bilateral measures to decrease tariffs on border zones (Brazil, Chile, Peru). US: FCC White Paper on Bill Shock published October 2010. Roaming featured in the paper.	
Asia-Pacific	ASEAN: Ministers announced in January 2011, the ASEAN Masterplan 2015, with intention to adopt measures to reduce roaming tariffs. Region is yet to adopt a unified approach to reducing roaming charges but has adopted best practice guidelines to improve transparency.	
Africa	SADC: Home & Away Roaming tariff transparency measures started in January 2011. 2nd Phase RIA II (Regulatory Impact Assessment) currently being conducted to provide concrete advice to ministers on the charges to apply within SADC countries
