Total 27 Ministers, Vice Ministers and Deputy Ministers from APT Members gathered together to commemorate the 35th Anniversary of the APT and set a high level guideline and commitments for the APT. The Asia-Pacific ICT Ministerial Meeting adopted the Brunei Darussalam Statement to emphasize to work collectively in the region to make a smart digital economy through ICT. They have identified six priorities areas for cooperation.

The second important event of 2014 was the 13th Session of the General Assembly of the APT. The General Assembly adopted the Strategic Plan of the APT for the Period 2015-2017. The strategic Plan included the high level commitments from the Brunei Darussalam Statement and emphasized to work on the six priorities areas. In order to address the priorities, the Strategic Plan has included eight key work items for the year 2015-2017, one of which is Radiocommunication.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Radiocommunication sector has been recognized as one of the major key areas of APT activities. APT is committed to promote applications of radio technologies and facilitate members' co-operation for spectrum harmonization, and to harmonize the regional views on Radiocommunication matters to present them at the relevant global forum such as the ITU World Radiocommunication Conference (WRC).

Since its inception, APG has been playing a significant role to harmonize the regional views at WRCs. It has been matured by developing more and more common proposals for WRCs for the interest of the region. APG has now become the APT's largest event attended by a large number of interested public and private sectors as well as delegates from other international and regional organizations. Regional preparations of regional groups like APG are highly appreciated by ITU as they can significantly contribute to the efficiency of the WRC.

Distinguished Delegates,

We are now almost at the final stage of our preparation for the WRC-15. The CPM15-2 is knocking on the door. APT region has considerable stakes in the agenda of the WRC-15 which

covers wide range of subjects, encompassing all types of radiocommunication services. Recognising that the tasks ahead are complex and diverse, we all need to work hard and consolidate our efforts with a view to preparing ourselves for the CPM15-2 and WRC-15, so that aspirations of all members are appropriately met and interests of the region, as a whole, are well protected.

The importance and the role of regional organizations are increasing for the preparation of major ITU Conferences. APT has been playing a key role for the success on major ITU Conferences, particularly for WRC. The same spirit of solidarity, fraternity and co-existence would be the key to our success in the future as well. I am confident that with your expertise, cooperation and mutual understanding, we will continue to achieve our goals collectively.
